The following information shall be submitted on attached sheets:

1. Site Plan
  - a. A USGS topographic map showing the property location and abutting landowner's property.
  - b. Abutting property owners within 500 feet of the cutting operation shall be given a copy of the completed application and notice that property boundaries are clearly marked.
  - c. Location of proposed logging operation including logging trails, water bodies and watercourses and other associated activities.
  
2. A Sedimentation and Erosion Control Plan
  
3. Narrative Description.
  - a. Type and number of vehicles to be used.
  - b. Proposed vehicular access to site.
  - c. Start and completion dates and hours of operation.
  
4. Inland Wetlands Review – Application attached

Four copies of the completed application and a fee shall be submitted. Approval shall be in effect for one year and may be renewed for one additional year by vote of the Commission.

I have read the Zoning Regulations for the Town of Killingworth governing Timber Cutting. I understand that a performance bond may be required to guarantee completion of all work in accordance with the regulations.
