## FOR DOGS

Setting up an emergency kit for your pets is a quick process, and are not only for times when you may need to evacuate your home, but are also used in events that may require to “shelter at home.” As with anything, the time to prepare is before the need happens. Here’s a quick checklist of the most important items you’ll want to be sure to include in your kit

*\*Kit Should Be Stocked For At Least 3 Days / 72 Hours*

- Dry food in sealed container
- Bottled water
- Fleece throw blanket
- Collapsible food and water bowl
- Extra leash & collar (slip-leashes are the best)
- Doggie cleanup bags
- Extra toys / stress relievers / treats
- Pet Identification Information
