June 22, 2011

Correspondence: First Selectwoman lino forwarded a letter from the DOT regarding their project to install and/or revise horizontal alignment warning signs in the State. Route 148 is the only road in Killingworth included in that project.

- **Speed Spy Deployment:** After chips are downloaded from Machines and returned to Town Garage, they will be deployed to Green Hill Rd.
- **Work Products for 2011 and Task Assignments:** This issue was tabled until the next meeting
