Updates at Parmelee Farm were reviewed

The MLUC long range plan for municipal properties was discussed in detail. An inventory of municipal property has been completed and it was agreed the properties to be included in the MLUC long rang plan are Parmelle Farm, Sheldon Park, Wettish Ball Fields, the Town Green and the State Police Office.

Our plan is to monitor the long range plans of Parmelee Farm and The Park & Recreations Commissions long plans for Sheldon Park & the Wettish Ball Fields. At our next meeting on March 22, 1012 we plan to meet with PRC to discuss their long range plans for both fields. We will also discuss the possibility of a trail to link Killingworth Elementary School with Sheldon Field.

The Town Green Plan is on hold pending a need, with the exception of a possible multi-use path to connect the Elementary School with the Library. The State

Police Office building will be monitored for future use and possible shared parking with the commercial property that adjoins on Route 80.

Old Business:

A Scope Confirmation Meeting was held with ConnDOT, next step, will be a public involvement meeting, no new information
