Maura Esposito made the following reports:

Reportable Diseases –Maura reported three reportable cases this month.

Environmental –

1. Maura reported completing three restaurant inspections and sent a letter to the food services clarifying their classifications and fee structure.
2. Proto-Pizza is open
3. Communicating with Temporary Event Coordinators
4. Inspected 5 public water supply wells with DPH
5. Water sampled Parmelee Farms
6. Submitted draft septic ordinance to DPH for review
7. Blood pressure clinic was held on May 7 and very successful
8. Soil testing included 1 repair, 1 B100 review
9. Reviewing plans included 1 repair, 3 B100's
10. Septic inspections included 1 new home, 1 repair and 1 partial repair
11. 49 pump-out re-permit to discharge were mailed
12. 3 complaints including noise, wood burning and a follow-up on housing complaint
13. Mental Health First Aid Course offered May 15, 17, and 31 in Middletown for \$20. Will distribute flyers in Town Hall.
