Minutes –September 26, 2012 - Roelofsen moved and Adametz seconded motion to approve minutes of September 26, 2012 with correction of the date in the call of the meeting to September 26, 2012. Adametz, Ellis, Roelofsen and Sturges voted in favor, Opposed: None, Abstentions: None.

Old Business

- Committee Membership status for 2012 – minus 1 member
- D.O.T. status of Route 148 – Ellis was contacted by D.O.T. representative who will review site work within next 2 weeks and report back to Ellis. Town has done all site work requested by the D.O.T. to date.

New Business

- Speed Spy deployment. The Speed Spies have been placed at two different locations on Green Hill Rd. This is a "recheck" of results from 2010. They will be moved to another location in 1 week.
- The safety concerns at the intersection of Green Hill Rd./River Rd. were discussed. There was a proposal several years ago to correct the sight line by adjusting the bank east bound on Green Hill Rd. Ellis will get that information to lino.
- In response to Mr. Ricciuti, the Committee will suggest more enforcement in the area of Stevens Rd. and Roast Meat Hill Rd. Stop signs are not currently used to slow traffic.
- Motion made by Adametz, seconded by Roelofsen to add Cow Hill Rd/Chittenden Rd intersection to agenda. Vote was unanimously in favor of addition to agenda.
