**MINUTES**

Regular Monthly Meeting  
February 22, 2012

Meeting called to order by Chairman Ellis at 7:07pm. Members present: Robert Ellis, Walter Adametz, George Roelofsen, and Carol Sturges. Absent: Ex-officio member Resident Trooper Matt Ward.

**Minutes:** Adametz moved, Roelofsen seconded the approval of the January 25, 2012 Monthly Meeting minutes. Voting in favor: Ellis, Roelofsen, and Sturges; Opposed: None; Abstentions: Adametz. Motion carried 3-0-1.

**Old Business**

- Speed Spy Deployment - The Speed Spies were placed on Schnoor Rd. for a period of about two weeks. They have been removed. The Town of Chester has asked to borrow them. The machines will be loaned for about 30 days in March. They will be deployed in Killingworth upon being returned.
- Town road traffic issues – Speeding noted on Green Hill Rd
- Publicity – Michael Hayes, from “*Durham, Middlefield, Killingworth Patch*” would like to write a traffic article using the Speed Spy data. Ellis will give him the data.

**New Business**

- Results of Speed Spy deployment – summary of data from Schnoor Road will be shared at our next meeting.
- Committee Membership for 2012/Officer Election – tabled until membership is complete.

**Comments from Committee Members**

- Town Infrastructure Items of Interest – intersections on Rt.148 will be finished this spring. Sweeping the roads will start when threat of snow is completely passed.
- Enforcement Items of Interest – None (Trooper Ward unable to attend meeting tonight)

**Chair's Comments** – Ellis, along with Trooper Ward and other Committee members, presented the Committee's budget proposal at BOS meeting on 2/14/12. Issues addressed in the proposal for the coming fiscal year were additional traffic safety enforcement by state trooper (\$18,000.), guardrail replacements (\$15,000-\$17,000), and an intersection improvement project (cost depends on the intersection/s chosen).

**Adjournment:** Ellis moved, Roelofsen seconded a motion to adjourn at 7:45pm. Voting in favor: Ellis, Adametz, Roelofsen, and Sturges; Opposed: None; Abstentions: None. Motion carried 3-0-0.
