Comments from Committee Members

- Town Infrastructure Items of Interest – (a) two juniper bushes still need to be removed from the Stonehill Dr/Route 148 intersection in order to get final approval from the State for speed limit changes on RT. 148.; (b) guard rails/posts are being replaced on town roads; (c) Speed dolly will be placed on Parker Hill Rd under the supervision of Mr. Richards.
- Enforcement Items of Interest – Trooper Ward has been asked to put the speed dolly within Jensen's to remind residents to drive carefully.
- Sturges noted guard rails/posts near her residence have been replaced as well as mowing has improved visibility.
- **Chair's Comments:** (a) Ellis received information from the First Selectwoman on the status of the Public Safety Grant. The money was used to correct drainage issues on Parker Hill Rd. adjacent to new fields at Wettish property. (b) Ellis suggested the speed spies be deployed to the Green Hill Rd, River Rd. intersection area.
