

**Minutes of the
SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN
Thursday, February 21, 2013 @6:00 p.m.
TOWN OFFICE BUILDING**

A Special Meeting of the Board of Selectmen was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by First Selectwoman Catherine Iino. In attendance were Fred Dudek and Lou Annino, Jr. Also present were Brian Mahoney, President of the Killingworth Ambulance Association; Cheryl Chandler, Kathryn Glendon, and Mark Torello, Youth & Family Services; Regina Regolo, Financial Director.

Brian answered assorted questions regarding the present operation of the Killingworth Ambulance Association. He described the challenges of finding and training volunteers. He explained how a volunteer earns credit towards a year of service which would qualify them for a reduction in their property taxes. He confirmed that the association continues to pay for the workers' compensation as invoiced by the town. He further confirmed that the association has agreed to pay for the life insurance that became effective in March of 2012. With regard to the pension benefits, the town will provide the cost of the current program and Wayne will present our request for funding to the association.

The representatives from Youth & Family Services described the current programs and services, the proposed programs for 13/14 along with their request for increased funding to meet the growing needs. Cathy Iino asked about the number of Killingworth residents served by the organization last year. Cheryl said that of the 84 clients, 34 were from Killingworth.

The next Special Meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, February 26th at 6 p.m.

Motion by First Selectwoman Catherine Iino, seconded by Selectman Dudek to adjourn at 8:30 p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
