**Enforcement Officer's Report:** Cathie Jefferson reported on the following items of business:

1. She spoke with First Selectwoman Cathy Iino about the erosion control mat by the reconstructed bridge on Reservoir Road. Town Engineer Howard Pfrommer will take a look at it and consult with Cathie Jefferson about the situation where there is no growth of material on the mat.
2. Cathie received a call from the Hastings (179 Route 80) and inspected the site on May 21st. The owners have not encroached on the wetlands with the activities that have been done. No regulated activities are proposed at this time. Staked hay bales and wood chips will be used in the area. Cathie will continue to monitor.
