- Annual Budget Request and supporting data/information: Ellis reviewed the requests made last year. Discussion included traffic enforcement, road safety and problem intersections. Ellis will draft a letter to Bd. of Selectmen, cc to Bd. of Finance, outlining our suggestions to include \$10,000 for enforcement, \$15,000 for road safety (repairing/replacing guard rails, etc.) and putting one of the problem intersections (either Green Hill/River Rd. or Green Hill, Coughlin Rd.) into the budget.
