- Speed Spy Deployment: Trooper Ward shared the data from Green Hill Rd. The average speed remains around 39 mph. Spies will be deployed in the Laurel Ridge area. Concerns about speeding on Roast Meat Hill Rd. have been raised as well.
- Stop Sign Grant: Adametz will notify the First Selectwoman that the Committee is in favor of seeking this Grant for installing/replacing reflective stop signs and pavement markings as described in Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Act, HRRR safety program.
