

Town of Killingworth Board Of Assessment Appeals Minutes for September 23, 2014

The meeting was called to order at 7pm by Chairman, Richard Albrecht. In attendance were Dan Haas, Sheila Ahearn and Richard Albrecht.

The following appeals for Motor Vehicles on the 2013 Grand List were heard and unanimous decisions were made.

Ronald Cyr 11 Country Club Trail for a 2003 Ford Ranger, presented that the truck is in good shape and average mileage for its age feels the way the state values automobiles unfair. The board decision was to deny any change to the current value for October 1, 2013.

Jessie Larson 13 Rebecca Lane for a 2007 Lexus ES350 this car has been in three accidents and has high mileage. The board decision was to reduce the assessment from \$11,800 to \$8,140 for October 1, 2013.

Janine Stoner 450 Route 80 for a 1999 Honda Civic which has been in 3 accidents. The board decision was to reduce the assessment from \$2,890 to \$1,670 for October 1, 2013.

Arthur Stoner 450 Route 80 for a 2008 Toyota Tacoma with 2 accidents and high mileage. The board decision was to reduce the assessment from \$10,550 to \$6,460 for October 1, 2013.

John Farrugia 42 Schnoor Road for a 1998 Ford Ranger. Truck is in average condition and mileage for age. The board decision was to deny any change to the current value for October 1, 2013.

Mary and David Locke 54 Schnoor Road for a 2012 Nissan NVSV van. The van has average mileage and in good condition. The board decision was to deny any change to the current value for October 1, 2013.

Jessica Jackson-O'Rourke 22 Bethke Road for a 2006 Acura MDX. Car is in good condition but has high mileage. The board decision was to reduce the assessment from \$9,800 to \$9,100 for October 1, 2013.

Anthony Uzwiak 33 River Road for a 2010 Ford Focus. The car is in good condition but has high mileage. The board decision was to reduce the assessment from \$8,230 to \$6,830 for October 1, 2013.
