COOPERATION AGREEMENT

**CONNECTICUT SMALL CITIES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK
GRANT PROGRAM**

This agreement entered into on the 28th day of March, 2014 by and between the Town of Clinton and the Town of Killingworth.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS the Town of Clinton has identified need in the municipality to provide decent housing and related conditions, and

WHEREAS the Town of Clinton contemplates submitting on behalf of the Town of Killingworth an application for Block Grant funds under the Small Cities Program of the Connecticut Department of Housing for the purpose of meeting such needs, and

WHEREAS the Town of Clinton and the Town of Killingworth understand that the Town of Clinton will act as the applicant and will have the ultimate responsibility to assume all obligations under terms of the grant including assuring compliance with all applicable laws and program regulations and performance of all work in accordance with the contract.

WHEREAS, it is understood that the Town of Clinton and DOH have access to all participants' community development block grant records and authority to monitor all activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant the Town of Clinton and the Town of Killingworth agree to cooperate in the submission of an application for such Block Grant Funds, and agree to cooperate in implementation of the submitted Small Cities Program, as approved by the Department of Housing.

Nothing contained in this agreement shall deprive any municipality of any power or zoning, development control or other lawful authority which it presently possesses.
