Special Meeting of the Parmelee Farm Committee

Tuesday September 23, 2014 – Town Hall

The following committee members were in attendance: Christine Cronin, Bruce Dodson, Terry Doyle, Linda Dudek, Karen Milano, Peg Scofield and Guy Vecchitto

Absent: Robert Broach and Tim Gannon

Peg Scofield called the meeting to order at 9:10 a.m.

Peg reviewed what had transpired at the meeting on Friday and that the committee has been advised by Mike Milano after he visited the site, that while the surface material that has been used on the parking lot and access ramp is a good material to top dress with gravel. The gravel should not be applied until the warm weather returns next summer. There was lengthy discussion

Peg Scofield, moved that the committee should do the underlayment on the farm driveway with the same material used for the parking area and access ramp and that it will be top dressed by Mike Milano at a later date, seconded by Linda Dudek. Passed. Bruce Dodson voted no.

Terry Doyle moved that the committee approve \$2,700 for the material to pave the driveway, seconded by Karen Milano. Passed. Bruce Dodson abstained.

Christine Cronin then spoke to the committee on behalf of the KWO. She stated that October is Domestic Violence Awareness Month and that the KWO is locating purple ribbons around town to commemorate this. They have asked that the committee agree to have a ribbon placed at the farm. There was discussion.

Terry Doyle moved that the committee approve and support the installation of the purple ribbon at the farm for the month of October, seconded by Peg Scofield. Unanimously passed.
