

## 350<sup>th</sup> Killingworth Anniversary Commemoration Committee

### Inaugural Meeting

April 28, 2015

Cathy Iino introduced the members of the committee and shared some materials related to the 1967 commemoration of the 300<sup>th</sup> anniversary.

It was decided that the Committee would schedule regular meetings on the 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of each month, at 7 PM, at the Town Hall Selectmen's Meeting room, but hold meetings only as determined to be necessary.

This committee can be seen as a steering committee with subcommittees addressing particular areas such as publicity, exhibits and lectures, parades and picnics, school-based activities, etc. After members reach out to town organizations to determine their interests in participating or heading up an activity, it can be determined who would lead those subcommittees. Future steering committee meetings could involve hearing back from those sub-committee chairs on progress.

\*(from town history--"Court of Election held in Hartford on May 9, 1667, it was ordered that "ye towne of Homonoscit shal for ye future be named Kenilworth – "[the spelling used until 1707, when it became consistently Killingworth])
