

Minutes of the September 19, 2015 Killingworth Board of Assessment Appeals Meeting

The Board of Assessment Appeals meeting was called to order at 9:00 am September 19, 2015, by Richard Albrecht. In attendance were board members, Richard Albrecht, Sheila Ahearn and Daniel Haas.

The following motor vehicle appeals were heard and decisions made.

Madison Vanderbilt representing Jessie Larson – 2007 Lexus ES350 this car has been appealed for the past 3 years, it has been in numerous accidents. The board unanimously agreed to reduce the assessment from \$8,040 to \$5,550.

Karen Feinberg – 2005 Highlander limited has high mileage, no power steering and damage from numerous accidents. The board unanimously agreed to reduce the assessment from \$7,960 to \$4,000.

Whitney Hall – 2002 GMC1500 has high mileage and rusted. The board unanimously agreed to reduce the assessment from \$5,230 to \$2,600.

Tadeusz Pienkos for TP Construction LLC – 1980 International dump truck. 2013 value was \$3,260, 2014 value increased to \$5,850. The board unanimously agreed to reduce the assessment from \$5,850 to \$3,260.

Richard Albrecht – 2005 Chevrolet Colorado has over 200,000 miles and accident damage. Richard Albrecht recused himself from the discussion and vote. Dan Haas recommended the value be reduced from \$8,510 to \$4,200 this was seconded by Sheila Ahearn.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:30 am.
