Gorski **MOVED** to approve and send to town meeting the appropriation of \$40,000 from the Town Hall Campus Generator and re-appropriate it to the Emergency Operations Center for Furnishings, Fixtures and Equipment. Gorski seconded the motion. Discussion: none. Voting in favor: McMahon, Celmer, Gorski, Anderson and Williams. Opposed: none. Abstentions: none. The motion was **carried**, 5-0-0.
