Chairwoman C. Reimers called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Minutes: The minutes of the September 8, 2015 Regular Meeting were approved by a consensus of the members.

Enforcement Officer's Report: Cathie Jefferson reported on the following:

- 1) She reported on her inspection of the Town project on Parker Hill Road. It has been seeded and graded and wood chips have been put down. Members discussed their concern about the stability of the bank. Cathie will continue to monitor the area.
- 2) Revised plans for the Old Coach Road Subdivision (between Rt. 81 and Roast Meat Hill Road) have been submitted to the Planning & Zoning Commission. The plan will be submitted to this commission for review. Members discussed the potential impact of this subdivision on the pond across Route 81. That area was not included on the original site plan submitted. Cathie informed the commission that the Town Engineer will look at the whole area during his review.
- 3) She asked the members to check out property on Route 148 that has some disturbance on the side of the house. The owner was issued a permit approximately 15 years ago to do some work on the site but the new disturbance is in a different area.
