Mr. Radcliffe is considering purchasing the 7.7 acre parcel across from #776 Route 148 and wanted the commission's input on the possibility of accessing a particular area of the property to build a house and barn.

The members walked the site with Mr. Radcliffe and his family and their real estate agent. The site is mixed hardwood trees and ledge. There is a stream that is intermittently dry that flows to a neighboring pond.

There was some discussion of crossing the stream at the point where an old road used to cross or at a more northern point where the lot is flatter. Additionally, the potential siting of the house, barn, and septic was discussed.

No motions were made, no votes taken and no communications were received.
