September 8, 2015

Chairwoman C. Reimers called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m.

Minutes: The minutes of the August 11, 2015 Regular Meeting were approved by a consensus of the members.

Enforcement Officer's Report: Cathie Jefferson reported on the following:

- 1) She reported on her inspection of the Town project on Parker Hill Road. The mats are down and the majority of the area to be seeded is done. The outlet is in and they are finishing up in the section by the ball fields. Across the street, the house has been taken down and the area has been graded. A wood chip berm is scheduled to be completed before winter.
- 2) Cathie reminded members about the Land Use Academy training in Haddam in October. S. Dowd indicated she would be interested in attending.
- 3) The August Building Permit list was distributed to members.

NEW BUSINESS

A. CACIWC Membership for July 2015-June 2016

Cathie Jefferson said she submitted the commission's application for membership renewal to Finance Director Regina Regolo for her to send with payment. The IWWC and the Conservation Commission submit together.

B. Visitor – Peter Cumpstone – pond clean-out – Parker Hill Road

T. Doyle made a motion, seconded by G. Johnson, to add this item to the agenda under New Business. The motion carried unanimously. Mr. & Mrs. Cumpstone would like to clean-out the pond on their property on Parker Hill Road. The pond, which is less than a quarter acre, was cleaned out in 1985. Enforcement Officer Jefferson said this is the best time to do the work because it is so dry. She will monitor the clean-out and make sure the silt fence is installed and working. The material from the pond will be used on the property. T. Doyle moved, seconded by G. Johnson, to treat this request as an as-of-right pond maintenance and approve the request. The motion carried unanimously.

C. Other

Terry Doyle and Eric Auer have completed the memorial for former IWWC member Gaylord Rockwell at Sheldon Park. A wooden bench, tree and plaque have been put in place in memory of “Rocky”.
