Meeting of Parmelee Farm Committee

Thursday October 1, 2015 – Town Hall

Tim Gannon opened the meeting at 7:03 p.m. and welcomed Scott Hawkins. The minutes from the meeting of September 3 and 14 were accepted as presented.

Peg Scofield reviewed the list of upcoming events – Lions Pig Roast – October 11, Kids Event 10/10, Pumpkin carving event 10/24 and A Place Called Hope Event 10/30. There was discussion. There was also discussion of the Two Coyotes program which is held each Tuesday at the Farm until early November.

Tim spoke about his wish to have signage on the pavilion and the restroom building listing all of those who donated time, labor and/or materials to the construction of these buildings. He will have a list of people to be included for the next meeting and asked committee members to think of any others who should be included.

Tim also spoke of the signage that was previously discussed which would be located as you enter the farm from the parking lot. Peg will select a few of the choices, make copies of what she found on the internet and have them for the next meeting so there can be discussion.

Tim said that he had gotten 3 estimates for the materials for the improvements for the room in the pavilion. Landon Lumber was the least expensive. The doors have been ordered and will be here in 4 to 5 weeks. He will also get estimated for the sheet rocking and insulation.

Tim reported that the work on the path from the middle school (old road) should begin soon. Mike Milano had told him mid-October. Tim will check with him.

The Christmas tree which was planted last year is looking sick. Linda will ask Karen to contact the place where it was purchased to see if there is a warranty. If not, Erik Auer will be contacted. There was discussion.

Bob Broach reported that there was an act of vandalism at the farmhouse. A rock was thrown through a window. There was discussion. Tim said that we own 2 security cameras and 2 recorders. The Committee will look the cost to get a security camera system in place.

The concert held at the Farm on Sept. 27th, went well and was well attended.

There was then discussion of the dividers being used in the parking lot. Some options were presented.
