Meeting of Parmelee Farm Committee

Monday September 14, 2015 – Parmelee Farm

Tim Gannon called the meeting to order at 7:05p.m. and welcomed John Byrne.

Tim Gannon said that he and John Byrne had gone to Landon Lumber to research the various possibilities for door/window configurations to be installed in the new room that will be built in the pavilion. John Byrne then presented to the committee the various combinations of doors and windows that could be used, using a model that he had made of the existing wall and the various sized doors and windows. There was lengthy discussion as to the cost, aesthetics and the light that they would create in the room.

Peg Scofield made a motion that the committee approve the finishing of the new room in the pavilion with the installation of two double doors with transom and three, double hung window unit with transom in the new room in the pavilion, seconded by Tim Gannon. Unanimously passed.

Tim will take this to the Board of Selectmen for their approval.

Tim announced that Linda Dudek had completed the application for the grant to the Killingworth Foundation for a golf cart for the farm and it has been submitted. The Foundation will be meeting October 5.
