

KILLINGWORTH 350TH ANNIVERSARY COMMEMORATIVE COMMITTEE

Minutes

July 26, 2016

The regular meeting of the Killingworth 350th Anniversary Commemorative Committee was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Vice-Chair Charles Smith in the Town Office Building.

The following members were present: Charles Smith, Les Riblet, George Dupree, Andrea Freibauer, Michelle Adametz and Linda Dudek. The following members were absent: Lucinda Hogarty, Carl Nord, Fie Budzinsky, Michael Parahus, Lewis Scranton, Franco Piscitelli, and Thomas Lentz. Visitors: Carolyn Anderson and Greg Wind.

Linda noted that Les Riblet's name was inadvertently omitted from the list of members in attendance in the June minutes. Vice-Chair Charlie Smith accepted the minutes as amended.

Michele and Greg left the meeting to discuss plans for the parade and picnic.

Les noted that his wife, Sallie has located the music from the original Killingworth Follies. Les suggested that Mark White, who had lived in town and participated in the Follies be contacted to see if he would be willing to play his guitar and sing some of the original tunes during the picnic.

Carolyn Anderson spoke to the members about the grant offered by TD Bank. She noted that the grant must be submitted by the end of this year. Carolyn has offered to write this grant and others that may become available. There was discussion on the various grants and sources of monetary support. It was noted that TD Bank also has a marketing budget that might also support the celebration. Charlie will compile a list of the possible grants and donors.

Michelle and Greg rejoined the meeting at 7:45 P.M. and spoke about ideas for the parade and picnic. Greg has drafted a letter to send to town organizations seeking commitments to sponsor events at the picnic. Greg attended the July meeting of the Parmelee Farm Committee and spoke briefly about use of the farm areas and possible food vendors including local organizations. He has contacted the town Health Director regarding food handling requirements. There was a brief discussion on traffic and parking issues.

Charlie received information from Franco on the 350th pamphlet. The Chamber will cover the cost of the printing which will be done by ABCO. The Chamber will print 3000 copies and expect it to be thirty to forty pages in length. They will begin selling ads for the pamphlet in the near future. Linda will get Franco a copy of the Tercentenary Booklet for a guideline on what was done for that celebration.

Charlie declared the meeting adjourned at 8:35 P.M.
