- KES Trail Update: Eagle Scout project: Doug Brown has indicated that due to his time constraints, he was unable to start on the Kiosk during the summer. At this time it is unclear if he plans to complete it or will pass on the project to another Scout.
- Recycling at the Killingworth schools:  
Dean met with the principal who is very interested in providing some programming for the students and has generated a list of areas for recycling at the school. Richards described some of the plans for engaging students in recycling activities, including information that the K. Elementary School is applying for a "Green Leaf" grant to help support the recycling effort.
- Notable Trees: Commission discussion of the factors that can be used to identify such trees, and possible ways to engage children in such a project. Richards is gathering information on similar projects in other towns in Connecticut.

- Gypsy Moths: Concerns about monitoring and removing the egg capsules. Some information will be collected that can then be provided to town residents.
