Gay reviewed the Madison-Middletown Bus Route that will become effective Either July 1 or October 1, depending on when the funding is received.

For the Senior reduced fare, ID from the 9 Town Transit will be required.

This route will not replace the Dial-A-Ride service.

Mr. Comerford discussed the probable consumers who will use the service including for transportation to and from work sites, medical appointments, attending the community college in Middletown. "Travel Training" service will be available to help consumers learn how to use the bus service.

It was noted that the buses can be flagged down along the route.
