Chairman Reimers called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

1) E Auer/E. Barnum Application for Permit for road and driveway in connection with a proposed 2-lot subdivision - 11 Burr Hill Road

The Commission reviewed the subdivision road and driveway for a proposed two-lot subdivision on a 9.2 acre parcel on Burr Hill Road. The road will cause minimal wetland interference as it is upland of roadway. The Commission discussed that no culvert was needed but the natural drainage could be allowed to remain with road. The Commission also looked at the location of a planned catch basin and speculated that it was not needed on the site.

2) J. Fitzgerald request for pond clean-out - 172 Roast Meat Hill Road

The Commission reviewed a request to clean out a pond on this site. The property owner would like to clean out the pond and afterwards install a liner in the 200' x 60' pond. The current pond area is only partially filled with water and has a lot of sediment. There is no inflow or outflow at this time due to the drought conditions. When the water is higher it could flow into a natural wetlands area that runs across neighbors' land (SE to S).

No motions were made, no votes taken and no communications were received.

The meeting adjourned at 10:30 a.m.
