1. Call to order – 7:42 pm
2. Attendance: Susan Dean, Marilyn Campbell, Joan Gay, Stephanie Warren

4. • Communications and Correspondence:
 - Organization Information: Dean noted that she has asked for a membership form from Rockfall, for KCC records.
 - Legislative/Conservation news: Legislative bills passed, or not passed were reviewed by Dean. None have a direct impact on Killingworth
5. Reports of Officers, Committees, and Organizations
 - Parmelee Farm-Susan Dean noted that the next 2017 Farmers market will be on August 12th
 - Historical Society: No report.
 - LCRVRPC -Stephanie Warren reported: the plan for the Pop-Up survey was scheduled to take place at the Parmelee Farm farmer's market in July, however, the company managing the pop-up event was late in providing the materials to the RiverCog. This meant that some of the expected dates for the 17 town schedules had to be re-set. The next proposed date for Killingworth is for the Parmelee market on August 12. Warren will help with the display and survey
 - KCC Education Projects-Stephanie Warren noted that the next KCC Library exhibit will be on "Dangerous Discards" and will run from July 14 to August 14th. The program on "Dangerous Discards" addresses the ways to properly recycle trash items, in order to help protect wild species, especially birds and sea creatures.
