Chairwoman Carol Reimers called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.

Minutes: The minutes of the August 8, 2017 Regular Meeting were approved by a consensus of the members. There was no September meeting.

Enforcement Officer's Report and Requests for Review

1. She reported on the State's Public Act regarding MediPods that can be put on a property to use for an elderly citizen. The Town has to allow them if requested. The MediPods hook into the existing well and septic system on the property.
2. The August and September building permit lists were distributed.

OLD BUSINESS

A. Revised Notice of Violation - C. Morgan - 116 Roast Meat Hill Road - replacement pipe

Enforcement Officer Cathie Jefferson reported that Town Engineer Tom Fenton met with Chip Morgan and his attorney, and First Selectwoman Cathy Iino to discuss the issue of the pipe in his driveway that was not installed properly. They reportedly reached an understanding that Mr. Morgan will let the Town replace the 12" pipe and set it properly. The driveway pipe will take the same water flow that it previously did and the Town will put a drain closer to the road that will take any overflow from the driveway pipe and take the water south across Roast Meat Hill Road. The plan is anticipated to be ready in early November.

B. Notice of Violation - S. Collins - 30 Granite Hill Road - filling within regulated area

Enforcement Officer C. Jefferson met with a contractor who is working on the property at 30 Granite Hill Road. He informed her that the when the dumpster that is on-site now is emptied, he will remove the construction debris from the wetlands.
