July 11, 2017

Chairwoman Carol Reimers called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Enforcement Officer C. Jefferson was also present.

Minutes: The minutes of the May 9th Regular Meeting and the June 13th Regular Meeting were approved by a consensus of the members.

Enforcement Officer's Report and Requests for Review

1. No action on the proposed IWWC fee schedule has been taken by the Board of Selectmen.
2. The June building permit list was distributed.

OLD BUSINESS

A. Revised Notice of Violation - C. Morgan - 116 Roast Meat Hill Road - replacement pipe

A certified letter, dated 5/26/17, was sent to Charles Morgan about the replacement pipe that was installed recently on his property. Mr. Morgan did not pick up the letter so a State Marshal hand-delivered a copy of the letter, dated 6/15/17 to him. Mr. Morgan called Enforcement Officer C. Jefferson to say he would not be able to attend tonight's meeting but will plan on attending the August 8th meeting. He said he would like to meet with Mrs. Jefferson before then to go over the Town Engineer's report on the drainage issue in that area of Roast Meat Hill Road.

B. V. Kavanaugh permit application for brush and tree removal around pond - 523 Roast Meat Hill Road

Members conducted a site inspection on June 20th. No wetlands concerns were noted at that time. Enforcement Officer C. Jefferson said she had a phone message this evening from Mrs. Kavanaugh stating the plants had been planted near the pond. *T. Doyle made a motion to approve the application and grant a permit for the clearing and re-planting around the pond. The motion was seconded by G. Johnson and carried unanimously.* Mrs. Jefferson will inspect the site.

C. Notice of Violation - S. Collins - 30 Granite Hill Road - filling within regulated area

Edward Arthurs attended the June meeting in response to a Notice of Violation that was sent about construction materials that had been pushed into the wetland area on the property. At that meeting he said he intended to have the material removed before the next IWWC meeting. Enforcement Officer C. Jefferson drove by the residence and nothing had been done to remove the materials. Mrs. Jefferson will send a reminder letter to have those materials removed from the wetlands before the August meeting.
