 - LCRVRPC-Stephanie Warren noted that the Killingworth Plan of Conservation and
Development was reviewed by the RPC and all members agreed that the Plan is consistent
with the State Plans and recommendations for town Plans of C and D.

The KCC voted, and unanimously approved a \$ 90 budget for the three sessions.
