**Regular Meeting
#18-7**

July 10, 2018

Chairman Terry Doyle called the meeting to order at 6:59 p.m.

Members present: T. Doyle, E. Pizzuto, G. Johnson, C. Reimers
Enforcement Officer C. Jefferson was also present.

Minutes: The minutes of the June 12, 2018 Regular Meeting were approved by a consensus of the members.

Enforcement Officer's Report and Requests for Review

Cathie Jefferson reported on the following:

1. The June 2018 Building Permit log was distributed to members.
2. She reported on a meeting with the Town Engineer at which a (hopefully) final drainage plan for lower Roast Meat Hill Road was presented. The culvert on Chip Morgan's property will be replaced with a 12" pipe. The water will flow into a catch basin and from there go into a detention basin. A new 15" pipe will be installed on the side of the Youngs' property to carry the water to the wetlands behind their house. A permit application will be submitted to this commission in the near future.

OLD BUSINESS

A. Chris & Denise Salafia (owner), Chris Salafia (applicant) permit application for installation of a 23' x 20' floating dock - 318 Roast Meat Hill Road

Members anticipate no adverse impact to the wetlands by construction of a floating dock at Lavender Pond Farm. *A motion was made by G. Johnson and seconded by E. Pizzuto to approve the application as submitted. The motion carried unanimously.* Mr. Salafia thanked the commission for their help and interest in improving the Lavender Pond Farm property. He invited them to visit the Farm to see the improvements.

B. Town of Killingworth (owner), Pack 18 Scouts and Killingworth Park & Rec Commission (applicant) permit application for a Frisbee golf course in the woods at Eric Auer Park (Killingworth Recreation Park) - 13 Parker Hill Road Ext.

Some of the commission members inspected the site of the proposed Frisbee golf course. No adverse impact to the wetlands is anticipated by construction of the disc golf course. *C. Reimers moved, seconded by G. Johnson, to approve the application as submitted. The motion carried unanimously.*

Dave Adametz informed the commission that he will be moving out of Killingworth and therefore unable to continue his position on the commission. Members are hoping to add two new commission members in the near future.
