1. Chairman Dan Colonia called the meeting to order at 7:32 p.m.
  
2. Minutes of: Regular Meeting on Monday, April 9, 2018  
**\*A motion was made by Glenn Johnson and seconded by Scot Thomas to accept the minutes of the April 9, 2018 Regular Meeting. Motion passed.**

3. No visitors were present.

4. Communications, Bills and Applications

c. No new applications were presented.

5. Treasurer's Report

The group discussed the budget line by line, noting remaining balances as well as work that remains to be performed. It was also noted that repairs to the Sheldon Park dam have been approved but not yet paid. The commission also discussed the Boy Scouts' disc golf proposal noting the process to be followed and the magnitude of the work involved.

## 6. Old Business

- a. Parks and Field Maintenance – Dan stated that the parks are in good overall condition.
- Sheldon Park – Glenn discussed an alternate repair plan for the dam breach suggested by Chris Plum of Arbor Gardens, but after in-depth discussion the group agreed the original plan was a more comprehensive and permanent solution. Glenn shared that IWWC had approved the plans. Dan explained that he asked Walter Adametz to clear a 5’ strip along the driveway and also to contact a tree contractor to remove the hanging branches and limbs. He agreed to ask KYL if the pallets had been removed.
  - Rocco Field - Dan had asked Charlie Rickert about the fence repairs at Rocco, Sheldon and Eric W. Auer KRP and is waiting for response. In-depth discussion followed.
  - Bethke Field – nothing new was discussed.
  - Eric W. Auer KRP – The group discussed the potholes in need of repair and possible solutions, agreeing that Drainscapes should present a quote for processed stone at the next meeting. Brian added that he asked a Killingworth stone contractor to look at the stone wall and submit a quote to repair.

## 7. New Business

Dan shared that Cathy Iino received a complaint about rude behavior by KYL coaches and players stemming from an incident at Sheldon Park when KYL was giving their players ice cream. Dan noted that he contacted Dan Glynn and was given a different account of what happened. Dan also left a message for the complainant but had not heard back.
