Peg reviewed the Farm calendar noting events that have been cancelled due to Covid-19 and those events that are still on. Tim noted that the Car Show and concert for June have been cancelled. July is still on at this date. There was discussion.

Linda said that the September Artisan Fair has not yet been cancelled, but the is still up in the air. There was discussion as to procedures to be used if and when the Fair is cancelled.

Tim announced that the town crew came to the Farm and helped move the rocks from over by the Schoolhouse to the field north of the Pavilion. Andrew Pighills supervised where the stone were put. There was discussion of the rebuilding of the stonewall in the field north of the Pavilion.

Terry Doyle moved to approve funds from the Parmelee Activity Fund not to exceed \$5,000 for the phase I of the rebuilding of the rock wall. Seconded by Peg Scofield. Unanimously passed.

Tim reported that he had been able to purchase supplies for next Year's sugaring at a discount of 10% off. Now they are all set for the 2021 sugaring season.

Bruce spoke about the trail signs and the fact that a new GPS map is going to be created. There was discussion.

Linda Dudek said that the Killingworth Historical Society might set up a table of tag sale items on the day of the Car Show and Concert. There was discussion.
